Matthews Fire Station Number 3, located in Matthews, NC, is a purpose-driven facility designed to support both emergency response and community connection. The station's layout emphasizes clear separation between operational zones and living or administrative areas—ensuring that firefighters can move efficiently between calls, training, and daily routines without overlap or disruption.

A standout feature of the station is its training room, a flexible space intended for fire training and public meetings, outreach events, and educational programs. This reinforces the building's dual role as both a functional fire station and a neighborhood resource. While the design prioritizes utility and performance, it also respects the character of its residential setting, blending seamlessly into its surroundings and reflecting the town's investment in practical, community-focused infrastructure.
