NEW FIRE STATION AU SABLE FORKS, NY



Completed in early 2025, the new Au Sable Forks Volunteer Fire Station located within the Adirondack Park region of upstate New York, is a transformational project that replaces an outdated, undersized facility of the 1950s with a modern, purpose-built fire station that enhances emergency response capabilities, operational efficiency, and firefighter health and safety. Built on a new site and inspired by the aesthetic of an Adirondack Great Camp, the fire station was designed to feel both welcoming and grounded in its rural surroundings.

This facility exemplifies forward-thinking fire station design for a rural community—balancing innovation and functionality while honoring the department's mission and community roots. It not only enhances response times and departmental functionality but also serves as a hub for community events and emergency coordination. The 13,500-square-foot station design places a strong emphasis on functionality, durability, and adaptability. It features eight full apparatus bays with four overhead bay doors and drive-through access, a dedicated decontamination zone, turnout gear storage, and a hose drying area—all organized to support NFPA best practices and minimize contamination risks.
